Global Expansion of the Ubiquitous ID Center and the T-Engine Forum: Technologies transferred to the world

The T-Engine Forum was established in 2002 as an organization to promote the T-Engine Project that builds development platforms for ubiquitous computing environments, and now has almost 500 members including overseas as well as domestic companies in Japan.

As part of the transfer of technology overseas, the Forum has been working together with local companies, universities and organizations in various countries, such as China, Korea, Singapore, Vietnam, Australia and Taiwan, and has actively established T-Engine Development Centers and the Ubiquitous ID Centers in these countries to promote and provide education on T-Engine and Ubiquitous ID technology. Furthermore, a number of feasibility study experiments that use ubiquitous ID technology have been conducted and achievements are steadily increasing.
